Archaeological Research Grant Guidelines

Eligibility:

- Projects in the field of Archaeology, Anthropology, Ethnology, History or related areas
- Projects with a focus on Central Oregon

Grant Proposal:

- Project title, objectives, description, and relevance to Central Oregon
- Project timeline
- Project budget
- Current CV that includes your name, academic affiliation, contact information, and a summary of your education, professional experience, research experience, accomplishments, awards, and/or publications.

Award procedures:

- Grants proposals will be accepted for review by ASCO on timing set by the Board
- Since the number of proposals may exceed available funds, ASCO reserves the right to partially fund requests.
- Applicants will be notified no later than 45 days following receipt of their proposal

Conditions of Awards:

- Applicant will provide ASCO with a short Project Description that can be posted on ASCO's website and shared with the membership
- On completion of the project, Applicant will provide ASCO a summary of the results of the project as outlined in the Grant Proposal. ASCO can post the summary on its website and in communications with members
- ASCO support will be acknowledged in all publications resulting from the grant, but endorsement of results and conclusions will not be implied.

Submitting your proposal:

- Please compile the application materials (Project title, objectives & description; timeline, and budget) into a single pdf document. Submit the combined application and Current CV to ASCO by email: ASCOinfomail@gmail.com
- Once your application and current CV have been received, you will receive a confirmation email from ASCO.
